



Australian Animal Bingo

Aim

To become familiar with Australian animals in English

Materials required Bingo cards (page 52) Animal picture cards (page 31)

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- (1) The teacher asks 'What is this?' while showing picture cards of animals. The children respond with "It's'.
- (2) The children practice by repeating after the teacher.
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Distribute bingo cards and animal cards, have the children choose cards of animals they like, cut them out and stick them on the bingo card grid.

3 Follow the conversation pattern 'I like XXX'. What animal do you like? I like XXX' and slowly read out an animal twice. If the children have the animal mentioned on their own sheet they place a tick. When they finish a complete row, vertically, horizontally or diagonally they call out 'Bingo!'.

Prepare a bingo game and bingo cards for practicing the expressions 'What animal do you like?', 'I like \sim ' and have the children stick the pictures on a grid.

Once the game starts each child asks a classmate 'What animal do you like?' and if the classmate answers 'I like kangaroos!' the child places a tick on the kangaroo section of their own sheet. Each child asks one question. When they finish a complete row, vertically, horizontally or diagonally they call out 'Bingo!' and take it to the teacher.

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
