

## Lesson plan for "Bluey in Brisbane"

Target: Upper primary and middle school students

Objective: Students to get a feeling for hearing English through watching an Australian cartoon

Duration: 45 mins

Situation: One-off class

Lesson material:

Lesson flow:

(First 5 min)

Greet children

Ask who knows an Australian cartoon and what image they have of Australian cartoons.

Give some background information on Bluey (meaning of Bluey, Australian cattle dogs, Brisbane, Southbank Park, etc)

Hand out worksheet and explain about the quiz.

(10 min)

Watch "Ice Cream" on YouTube.

(5 min)

Give time to answer (children can work in pairs or groups)

(10 min)

Answer questions. Ensure to ask children what their answers were first.

(10 min)

Watch "Bluey Locations in real life!".

(5 min)

Reflection and any remaining last questions/messages.
